VINEYARD NOTES

Our Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir consistently delivers high value. It is sourced from exceptional vineyards in the revered Sonoma Coast AVA. Blending select lots from Roberts Road Vineyard, Dutton Ranch, Las Brisas Vineyard, Moore Ranch and Simpatico Ranch incorporates and balances the distinct flavor profile of each site. The resulting wine is interesting and complex yet easy to drink.

TASTING NOTES

The nose is beautifully expressive—rich and lively notes of red plum, sweet red cherries, baking spices and a hint of toasty oak fill the glass. The complexity follows through on the palate as a tapestry of red fruits—ripe strawberries, Rainier cherries, plum and wild raspberries—are woven together with nutmeg and warm earth. This is a great expression of Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir offering layers depth and balanced acidity.

Method: De-stemmed, cold soaked for 6 days in stainless before going through fermentation. Basket pressed when dry.
