

# 2021 FLORA MARIE GRENACHE



The Flora Marie Vineyard is located on Eastside Road in both the Russian River and Sonoma Coast appellations. Nestled in the rolling hills, this vineyard affords warm, sunny days though cools off significantly overnight, extending the ripening season. It has been a source for our Turbine Rose of Grenache and, in this vintage, we decided to make single-vineyard bottling.

Fun Fact: Grenache is known as a component of a GSM blend but is quite delicious on its own.

## TASTING NOTES

NOSE Muddled red raspberry, cherries, subtle clove

PALATE Juicy red fruits grilled plum, sweet floral and blood orange rind

FINISH Bright with a hint of herbs de Provenece.

### CHEF NOTES

Grenache has mild tannins and a medium body making it a delightful partner to poultry dishes like chicken cacciatore or crispy game hens. It's lovely with roasted vegetables too - try roasted parsnips.
