



## 2021 LAS BRISAS VINEYARD PINOT NOIR

### ABOUT

The Las Brisas Vineyard, part of the Mahoney Estate, translates to “the breezes” and sits on the Sonoma side of the Carneros appellation. It is named for the winds that drive morning fog from the vineyards and bring in cooling breezes in the late afternoon. The predominantly clay soils of Carneros are shallow. This, combined with the influence of the nearby San Pablo Bay, yield remarkable fruit year after year. This 2021 vintage was a standout year.

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*Fun Fact: We have been making a vineyard designate wine from this vineyard since 2011.*
