NOSE Raspberry, Rainer cherry, and notes of clove and rose petals

PALATE Wild cranberry, pomegranate, allspice, juicy and balance acidity

FINISH Lingering with silky tannins

CHEF NOTES

This Pinot Noir would do well with roasted duck with a fruit compote - bringing out the fruit forward notes in the wine. Also try it with grilled pork tenderloin, roasted mushrooms, or mild cheeses.
