La Colline embodies Anaba's founding vision, inspired by owner John Sweazey's profound experience in France's Northern Rhône. There, standing on a "colline" (hillside), John was deeply moved by the region's spirit of family and hospitality. This sparked a dream to create a serious, high-quality Rhône-style blend in California. Winemaker Katy Wilson dedicated nearly a decade to sourcing just the right Sonoma mountain vineyards, crafting a wine that honors that vision with exceptional quality and genuine connection. This is the inaugural vintage.

TASTING NOTES

NOSE Nice depth of aromas - olive tapenade, subtle black pepper, black currant, thyme

PALATE Layered, firm structured tannins, brighter fruit than the nose - strawberry, fresh black plum, clove

FINISH Complex fruit and spice notes with a lingering rich and structured oak presence

CHEF NOTES

The wine's structure makes it an ideal partner for rich, savory dishes like lamb ragu with pappardelle or braised short ribs. Its depth also shines alongside spiced roasted root vegetables or aged, firm cheeses.
