ABOUT

Bismark Vineyard is located in the Mayacamas Mountains, high above the city of Sonoma, in the sub-appellation of Moon Mountain District. Sitting at an elevation above the fog line at 2,100 feet, this steeply sloped vineyard benefits from cooler temperatures, yet experiences intense sunlight, adding to the depth of this wine. The soils in the vineyard are rocky and well draining, yielding fruit with a beautiful concentration of flavors.
