



2022 PINOT NOIR LAS BRISAS VINEYARD

ABOUT

The 2022 vintage from Las Brisas Vineyard in Carneros exemplifies the region's signature terroir. "Las Brisas," meaning "the breezes," speaks to the vineyard's defining characteristic: the winds that shape its fruit. Every morning, the vineyard is shrouded in fog, which burns off by midday as the winds usher in cooling breezes from the nearby San Pablo Bay. Grown by the Mahoney family, pioneers in Carneros Pinot Noir, this vineyard embodies the appellation's unique qualities. The shallow clay soils and San Pablo Bay's influence contributed to the exceptional concentration of this vintage, resulting in a wine of remarkable character and balance.
