ABOUT

Named for our estate's wind turbine, Turbine Red is a Rhone-style blend reflecting the diverse terroir of Sonoma County. Sourced from select sites across Moon Mountain, Sonoma Mountain, Dry Creek Valley, and the Russian River Valley, each variety provides a structural layer to this complex, balanced wine. The cool 2023 season yielded an extended hang time, delivering full phenolic maturity at lower sugar levels with bright, energetic acidity.

flavors. It's great with smoked brisket or za'atar-rubbed
roasted cauliflower. The wine's lively lift also makes it a go-
to for a fennel sausage pizza or a simple charcuterie
board with aged Manchego and salty salumi.
