This WestLands Pinot Noir is a nuanced expression of the West Sonoma Coast's unique terroir. The fruit is sourced from vineyards situated along the western edge of the Sonoma Coast AVA, where the Pacific Ocean exerts a profound influence on the vines. Winemaker Katy Wilson meticulously selected the finest barrels from this exceptional vintage to craft a wine that showcases the elegance and complexity of this remarkable region. The 2022 vintage started early and finished quickly yet delivered nicely ripened and balanced fruit.

NOSE Fresh red fruits and berry compote
