



2023 PINOT NOIR SANGIACOMO ROBERTS ROAD VINEYARD

ABOUT

This Pinot Noir comes from the Sangiacomo family's Roberts Road Vineyard in the Petaluma Gap. As multi-generational farmers with a deeply respected reputation in Sonoma, the family planted this site in 1999 at the western base of Sonoma Mountain. The region is known for its steady cooling from coastal fog and wind, which combined with the excellent drainage of the silty gravel soils allows for a long growing season and helps define the wine's specific character. An especially long growing season in 2023 allowed for extended hang time, resulting in a balanced wine with bright acidity and refined fruit concentration.
