ABOUT

Situated on the rolling hills of Eastside Road, Flora Marie Vineyard sits in a unique pocket of the Russian River Valley where warm days are balanced by sharp overnight cooling. This temperature swing is essential for developing deep fruit complexity while maintaining crisp acidity. The 2023 vintage saw an exceptionally long, cool growing season, allowing for an extended hang time and a patient harvest. This extra time on the vine resulted in a wine with refined structural balance and concentrated aromatics that capture the energy of this standout site.

NOSE Pomegranate, red cherry, blood orange, nice spice
from whole cluster, subtle floral
PALATE Bright, complex, red fruits and spice with a touch
of garrigue
FINISH Firm tannins yet supple

This bright Grenache is a great match for herb-roasted lamb, grilled Mediterranean vegetables, or spice rubbed grilled chicken thighs. It also pairs perfectly with a casual spread of rosemary-infused cheeses and charcuterie.
